#### **BASIC PROTECTIVE MEASURES AGAINST COVID-19 INCLUDE:**

- Travel: Avoid travel to locations with prevalence of COVID-19. Check with U.S. State Department for warnings (<a href="https://travelmaps.state.gov/TSGMap/">https://travelmaps.state.gov/TSGMap/</a>) and other resources provided below.
- Hand Washing: Wash hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. In the absence of soap and running water, use an alcohol-based hand rub with at least 60% alcohol.
- Social Distancing: Maintain at least 6' distance between yourself and anyone who is coughing or sneezing.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
